30 CREDITS IN TOTAL + **40** HOURS OF COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT +  COMPLETION OF THE LITERACY REQUIREMENT

Students must earn the following compulsory credits to obtain the Ontario Secondary School Diploma:

12 Elective Credits	Credits
Students are required to take:	
✓ 4 Religious Education courses, one each year in grades 9-12.	12
✓ 8 Optional credits that match their interests or develop their skills.	
Other Requirements	
✓ Community Service completed over 4 years.	40 hrs
<small>Note: Grade 8 students can start their service hours in July and August before grade 9.</small>	
✓ The Provincial Literacy Requirements OSSLC or OSSLC
