At Grade 12 graduation, students will receive a certificate acknowledging that they completed four years of French education.

DELF Certification



In Grade 12, students can choose to complete the B1 level exam. This international French standard certificate is very useful for future employers. It indicates your level of French fluency.

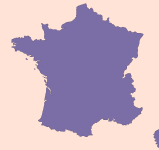

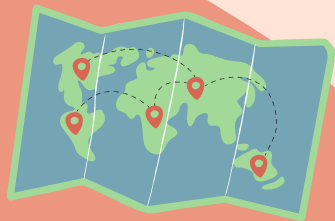
